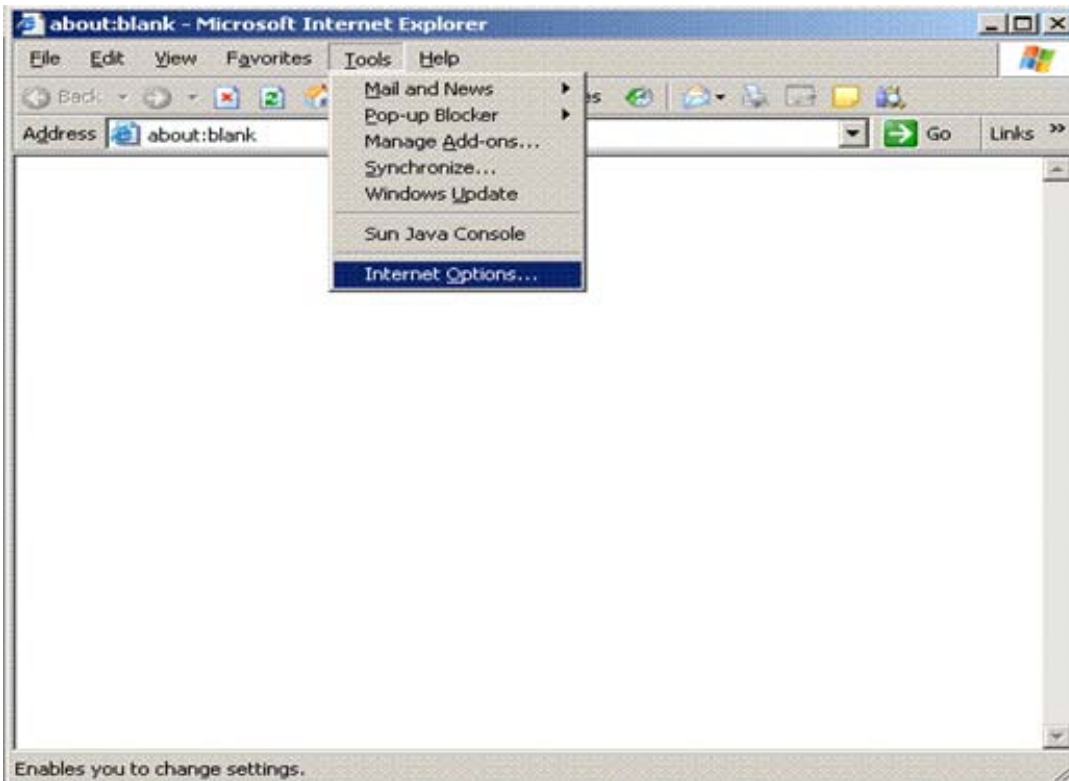
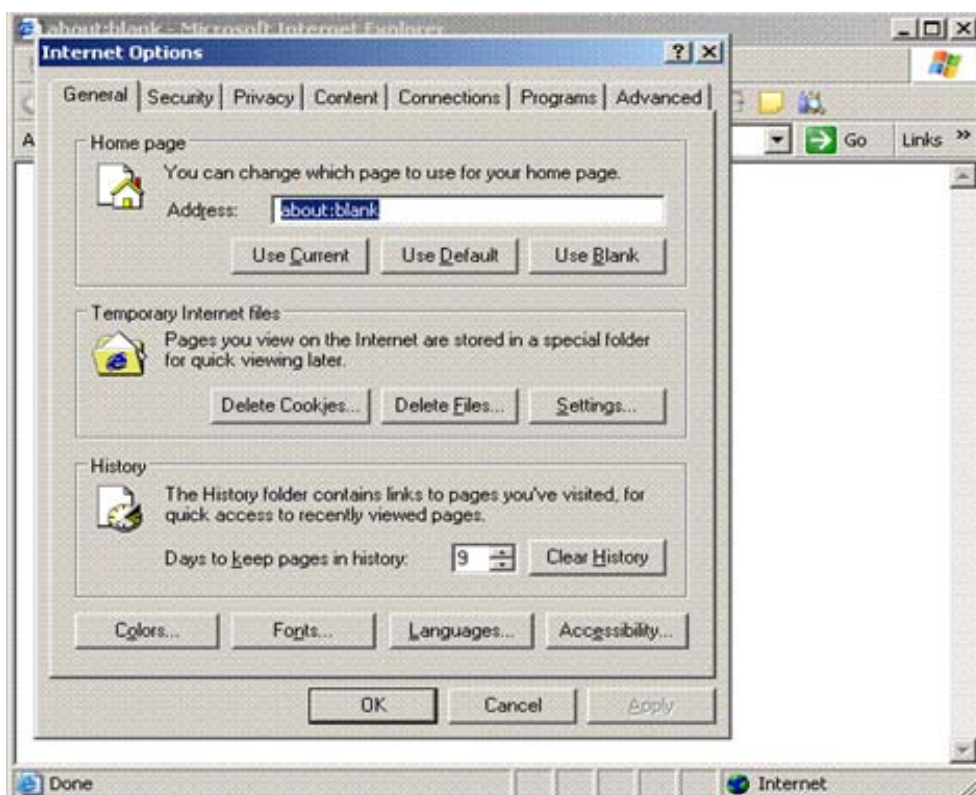


Internet Explorer Security Settings for Windows 2003 to enable Digital Signatures

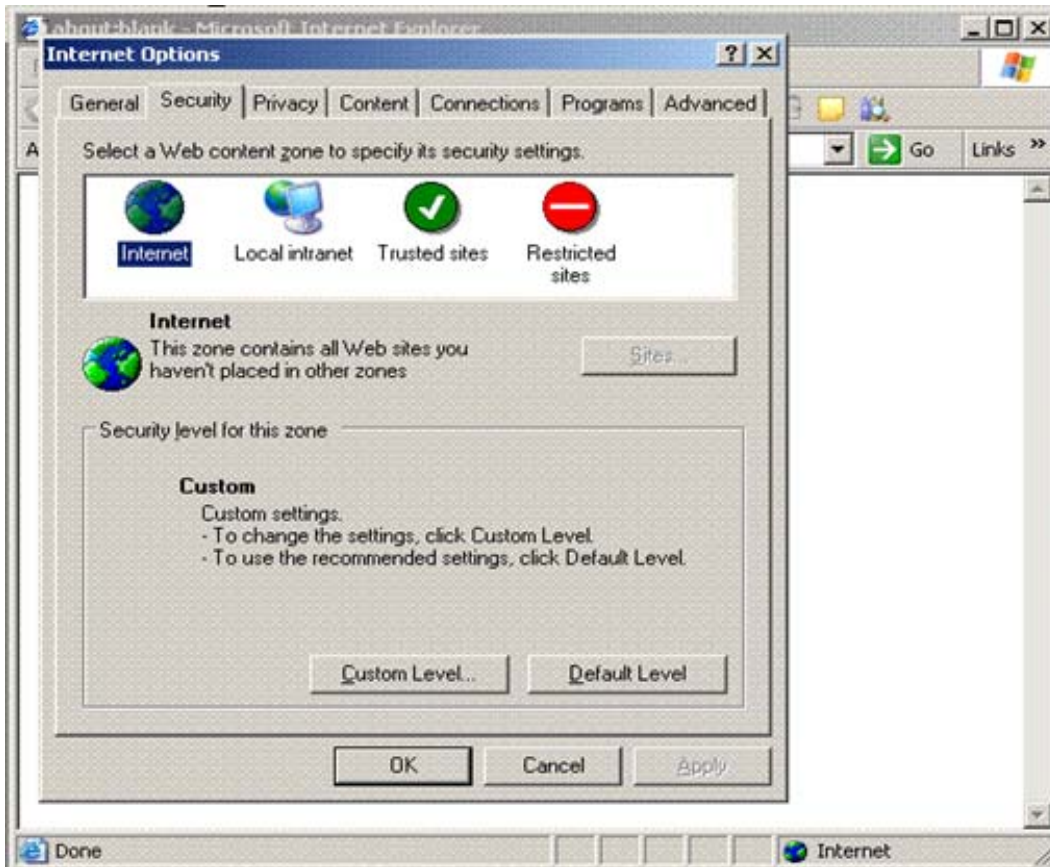
For internet browser settings, to enable digital signature, go to menu bar and click the option Tools, it will display different menu options, have been shown below. From the menu option Internet Options will be selected.



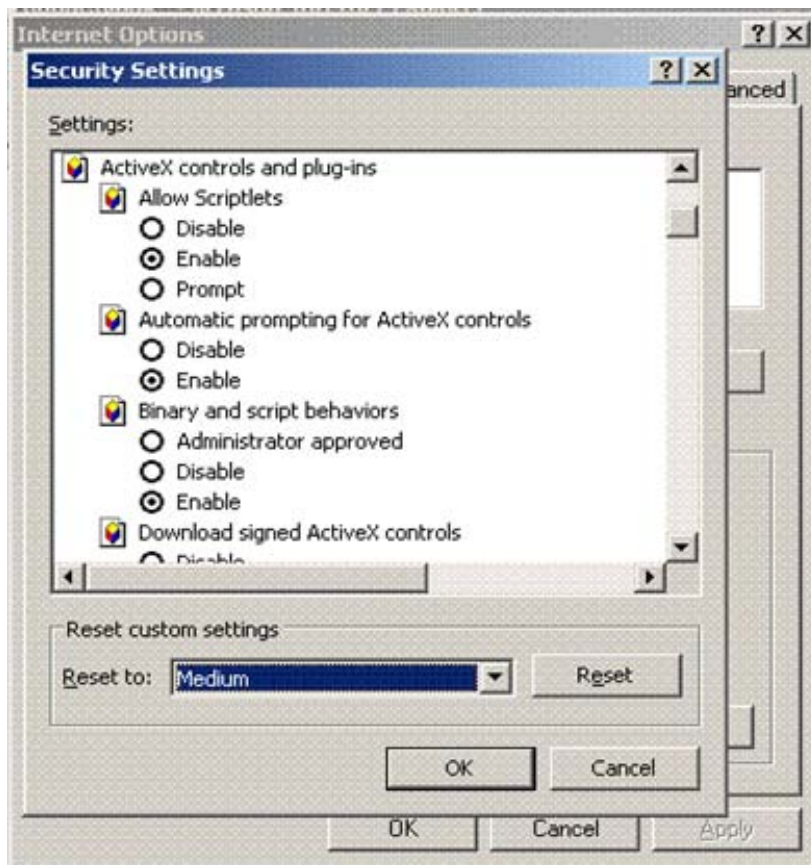

Set The following Settings If you have **windows 2003** Operating System:

Automatic Prompting for ActiveX Controls -> Disable

Binary and script behaviours -> Enable

Download Signed ActiveX Controls -> Enable

Download UnSigned ActiveX Controls -> Disable

Initialize and Script ActiveX controls not marked as safe -> Enable

Run ActiveX Controls and Plugins -> Enable

Script Activex controls marked safe for scripting -> Enable

Do not save encrypted pages to disk -> Unchecked
